Product News: Scopus Cited By Links To Be Added to Compendex & Inspec

This August, Engineering Village customers subscribing to Compendex will be able to see the Scopus Cited By count for each Compendex article that has a Scopus Cited By count. EV users will immediately see how many times a particular article has been cited from more than 18,000 titles covered within Scopus. The Cited By feature gives users an indicator of scientific value for a particular article. Even if an EV user is not subscribed to Scopus, users will see the Cited By count and view the citation listed in Scopus with limited access to other functionality.
